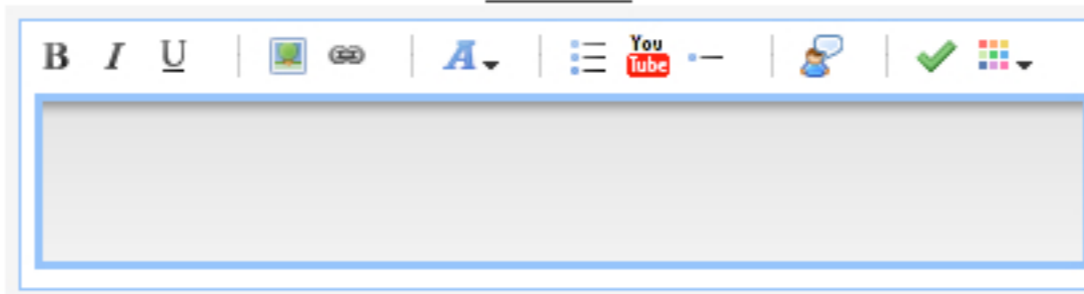

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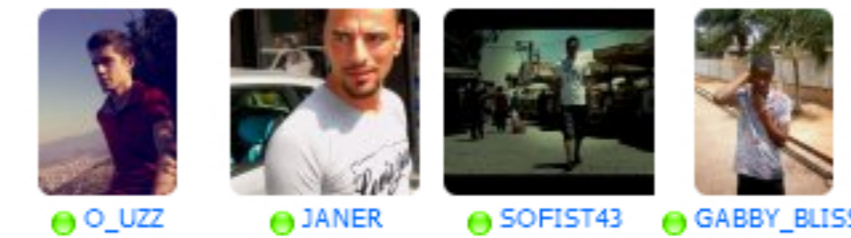
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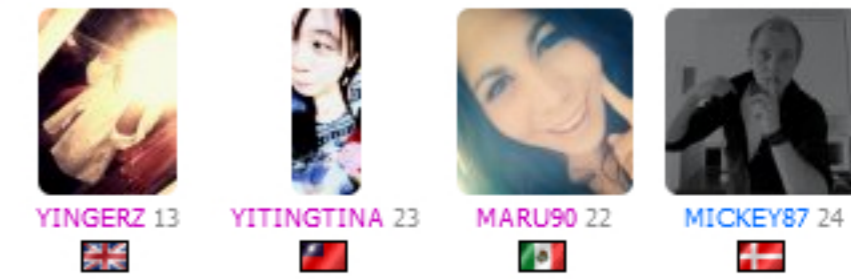

and nope i dont care about being anonymous or not , we have just broke the wall of fear lately which we have been living since we were children from the governments ,specially after i lost a friend a week ago and another one got arrested just for going out in peaceful demonstrations shouting " we want our freedom" and "we will never sell out our children blood"
if u r watching any news about Syria U would know that there have been more than 3000 innocent person got killed in the past 6 months , just for calling for freedom and more than 20,000 got arrested for that ,and by arrested its not just a prison , they get tortured every day for several times , with every kind of brutal techniques , smacking on the head and face ,burning them, and sometimes cutting their manhood ,and force them to say "Bashar alasad is My GOD"
the lucky ones are the ones who leave in a week after they force them to sign a paper which says "i promise that ill never go into demonstrations ever again ,and if i did then i deserve to be jailed for 15 years"

and they dont allow any press to get in ,so we are using our own cameras or mobile cam to show the world what they are doing to us , and when some of us get caught while he is recording ,he will mostly get killed, they have their own press only in the streets and they say that those demonstrators are terrorists !!!
terrorists with single hands and some large papers

is that we used to run away from school for 2 hours and go have breakfast out side and then we go to a network gaming center play some shooting games in 2 teams ,for an hour and then get back to school and mostly we didn't get caught :D

ive witnessed the first school violence when I was at six grade on which they used to let the student take off his shoes sit on the chair and call 2 other student to hold his legs (I had to hold someones leg once) and then the teacher hit him on his legs till he cries
and there were some punishments on which you open the backside of ur hand and then the teacher strike you with his/her stick on the bones of ur hand
ive been through that once by a female teacher

Re: Syrian culture :)

Hi Ida,

I'm going to give it a try. If you have more questions afterwards, you're of course welcome.

1. The schoolsystem is build on four different schools, from first grade (at six year) to the graduates, which is the 12th grade. There are schools from first to third grade, fourth to sixth grade, seventh to ninth grade and tenth to twelfth grade. There are exams in the ninth and twelfth grade, in twelfth grade this will decide your 'fate' as what kind of university or institute you will be able to go to afterwards. The schools are divided in schools for boys and girls (this is different in private schools and Christian schools and very small villages).

2. Although computers are being used, the system is still quite old-fashioned in being just lessons for the whole class (not many projects in groups and that kind of thing). There are books varying for every grade and subject. The subjects being from first grade: Arabic, maths, English and a little of social studies, religion (for muslims it's focused on Islam, for Christians on Christianity) and biology. The subjects increase when children get older, in seventh grade many subjects are added like: French, chemistry, physics, computer-classes. After tenth grade people can chose whether they want to go for the beta-or alpha classes and there's a little room for art as well. The beta will focus on maths, biology, chemistry and physics, the alpha will focus on social studies, the languages and religion and philosphy.

3. As children are small they will be treated with a lot of love, babies for instance are never left to cry. When children get older, the treatment gets a little thougher. Children will be hit, but in most families this is something which happens when things really get out of hand, it's not like Syrians are hitting their children all the time. The contrary is probably true, they will say that Western people are very cold towards their children. Children get praised by hugging and cuddling, with sweets. In school it's officially forbidden to hit children, but especially in boys-schools it happens all the time. Most classes consist of about forty children and 40 ten-year olds would be quite a test for any person I guess. Children which are doing well get praised after exams, sometimes they receive gifts from their teachers and they get rewards when they do exceptionally well.

4. When I came to live here Syria was really a "closed" country, where relations with the outside world were difficult: no internet, no mobile phones. With the coming of the new president (Bashar Al-Assad) this changed, mobile phone and the internet flooded the country. Many websites remained closed off, but it became really easy to have relations with the outside world. Freedom of press was (and is) another story, there's no freedom of press, although this was mainly to do with the president and his party and religion (meaning that nothing bad could be said about the president and his party and it was dangerous to be a fundamentalist muslim).

5. Syrians are really fond of food. This being said, the food varies a lot throughout the country, with every region having its own specialties. Breakfast consists of bread with jam, eggs, olives, butter and stuffed aubergines, tea is mainly drunk next to it. The main meal is lunch, which can consist of many things, often there's rice served with chicken, sometimes there's vegetables cooked in tomatoe-sauce with rice next to it. Often a salad will accompany the meal. Dinner is mainly the same as breakfast althoug people might have a snack of falafel or shoarma. Syrians love sweets, so often an occasion will be found to eat sweets, which there are in a great diversity.

6. Family is very important to the average Syrian. Most families are quite big, people used to have eight to ten children easily. Now families are getting smaller, especially in the cities, many people are having two, three or four children. One child is exceptional and this only happens when people can't have another one. Originally parents would live together with their married sons, their wives and children. Also unmarried or divorced or widowed daughters would be living with them. There would be a room for every family. Still many people live this way, but many people will leave their parents now to live on their own after marriage as well. Usually old parents are being taken care of by one of the children.

7. When it comes to Islam it's important to realise that many Syrians are not muslim, about 12% of the population is Christian and there are many Alewites as well (like the president and his followers), who are officially called muslims, but whose religion is very different from what most people consider Islam. Young muslims vary a lot among themselves as well. Some people are very conservative, girls covered from hands to face, other girls will be wearing the hjab (the headscarve) but with modern clothes like jeans. And many girls will not cover at all, but still consider themselves muslim. Some people are very severe in their faith and believe that only they are the rightly guided, others will be more open and tolerant.

I hope you can use what I wrote to you. And like I wrote in the beginning, if some things are not clear or if you have more questions, you're welcome to ask me.

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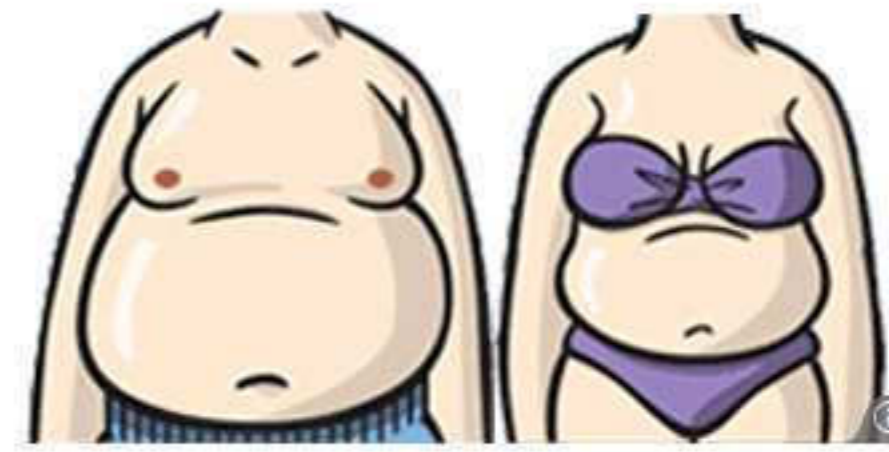

Hi Ida,

I'm going to give it a try again.

1. There are no special places for gymnastics in most schools (in private schools there are), but gymnastics is played outside, as the weather in Syria is very consistent and mostly dry.

2. The same is true for the assembly hall (again, this is different in private schools), especially on the first and last day of the week, the children are assembled in the schoolyard and sing the national anthem, while the flag is being raised.

3. There usually is a library available, certainly at the bigger schools.

There are no smoke alarms, air conditioning, there are ventilators though. The size of schools varies greatly. In an average school there may be something like 5 first grades, 5 second grades and 5 third grades, which makes for 15 classrooms. Other schools can be much bigger, in villages the schools will be smaller, as there are simply not so many students. White boards are widely used and available in most schools. The size of a classroom will be something like 6 by 6 meters. School furniture is mainly from wood and will be renewed every once in a while. As most school have two shifts (one in the morning and one in the afternoon) everything is used very intensively.

When it comes to the materials you mention, as far as I know flip art isn't being used. The other things are being used but things also depend on the teacher, some being older and maybe old-fashioned and not into using modern materials. Movies are watched, geography charts are being used and available both in the classroom and in schoolbooks.

Real gifts are given to the smaller students, these maybe dolls, cars, boardgames and when children get older something like a necklace or bracelet.

When it comes to attitudes about western states, there is attention for the state Israel and the role western states (mainly Great Britain and the USA) played and play. There is also attention for the big historical events like the 2nd world war, the cold war. Also is attention payed to for instance famous artists and musicians (like Beethoven and DaVinci). As far as I can see there's no special attention payed to western society in general.

Parents seem less involved in the school system. When it is necessary a parent will be asked to come and see the teacher, but there are no regular parents' evenings or such. Most parents aren't happy with the violence, but no action is taken against by them. Parents of course do complain when their child will be hurt. There is not something like career counseling. But there are excursions and trips (normally, at this moment there aren't, simply because it's too dangerous).

Lunch isn't offered because of the simple reason that the days in school are not very long. Either from 7 till 12 or from 12 till 4. Children will eat at home before and/or afterwards.

Most parents will help their children with homework, this is really necessary, because the pressure on children is quite high (as I'm from Holland, I know it's much, much higher than in Holland, I can't judge about what this is like in Germany, but I don't think it differs that much) and with some subjects they really need help if they aren't extremely bright.

Again, if you have more questions, you're welcome. And I'm curious of course what you are going to do with all this information.

1. From when until when people speak of infancy?

If I understood well, your question In general people speak of infancy from the birth until the baby has two years (or the time the mothers stop breast feed for their children).

2. What is feeding babies in Syria about? [Are there any special foods, rites?]

In the first two years mother give their babies breast feed until the age of two (if they could give milk for this period unless they give their children some milk like Nedo), and when the babies have the age of six months, mother become to give their children some nutrition food such as Cerelac in addition to Milk and after the age of two children eat almost everything.

3.a) Are there institutions, which support motor and speaking abilities?

There are some institutions but they are not in a big number and almost they are all ruled by the government. And most of them don't give a professional help.

b) In which way is the help effected?

I don't have much information about that, but what I can say that I didn't see any children have a benefit from such institutions

4.a) Are there institutions, which support the health of the little children?

Yes, there are hospitals and clinics which are specialized in children diseases.

b) In which way is the help effected?

Most of those institutions are public (owned by the government) and the treatment are almost free

They can help in surgeries for children and give a free medications for families, and of course there are private hospitals and clinics which give a better care but they don't have much attendance.

5. Can you tell me how babies grow up in Syrian families?

[Tasks of the father/mother, role of siblings, strong upbringing?]

In general bringing up children is the responsibility of mothers but fathers do much less work in the upbringing process (Because the men in the Syrian society have to work and collect money and women have to stay at home although with moderation much and much married working now but still fathers don't help much in upbringing. You can say it is kind of male society) , some mother depends on the elder siblings of the child to help her and others depend on the grand mothers.

But sorry I don't know what u mean by strong upbringing.

6. Go mothers with her babies regularly to a doctor to check the health? (precautions)

Yes, as I mentioned earlier in Syria there are much of public and private clinics and they could have help in those clinics although the care is different from a city to city and from urban areas to rural areas.

7. Are in Syria kindergartens? If yes, how is the relationship between the child and the nursery nurse?

Yes, there are public and private kindergartens but people prefer private ones because they offer a better education and treatment. To be honest it was not common for people to send their children to kindergartens but it became very common especially in the last five years.

8. What about the hygienic conditions in kindergartens? (Are they modern or old?)

In most cases those conditions are good, no one will send his/ her children to a place where they could have infections. I think conditions are almost modern.

9. Offers the state leisure facilities for little children? If yes, tell me about the possibilities, please?!

As far as I know, the government don't offer much of leisure facilities except public parks

And it is not very common in rural areas.

10. What about the "rank" of the child in Syrian society? Is it already bound in Islamic traditions?

Rank?? If I understood well

Syrian society don't expect much from the children (when I was a kid, I and my friends we always were looking for a place we can play football and we couldn't find all the time)

About Islamic tradition

Not all of the Syrian population are Muslims

About 70% are Sunni Muslims, about 15% are Alawi Muslims, 10% are Christians and the rest are Druze

Every sect has its way in upbringing children but almost all of Syrian bring up children in ways relating to religion.

PART TWO

1. What do teenagers prefer to eat [Are there any special foods, fast food, wholesome food?]

Teenagers love chips and biscuits not much of fast food, and families here keep looking at the food of the teenagers.

2.a) Are there institutions, which support motor and speaking abilities?

Not much as the institutions for children, not a big number of such institutions and they don't have a good experience.

3.a) Are there institutions, which support the health of teenagers (check up at school)?

In school no I almost remember that once in at my study a people came to threaten us from the danger of Aids, no more

One thing it may worth to be mentioned that from 7 years every school has a psychological assistant but they don't work much.

4.What are schools in Syria about? Can you tell my general circumstances?

Education are obligatory on Syria for 9 years, but we have much of Illiteracy in women especially in the rural areas, in general there are 30 to 45 students in the classroom. Students learn all subjects in Arabic and they learn also French and English (but Syrians are not good in speaking English and French due to the bad education). the courses are intensive but there are lack in practical side (like laboratories, locations visits,etc). the quality of teachers are not good because the education are almost totally public. there is no trees or gardens in schools only cement yard.

Schools don't offer meals for students, so students eat in home.

5.Wear the teenagers school uniforms? (Are they long or short ? ...)

Boys and girls wear a nearly similar uniform. (just a pants, shirt and jacket).

6.What about the hygienic conditions at schools? (Are they modern or old?)

Old in most cases.

7.How are the lessons constructed?

a)Is there teaching in shifts?

b)Which teaching material become needs?

c)What is the curriculum of school about?

A) there is no teaching in shifts, students go to school from 8 am to 1:30 pm (but in some areas where there is lack of schools there are two studying hours group, the first from 7:30 am to 12. And other students come from 12:30 am to 5 pm.

b) I don't understand the second question sorry.

C) curriculum contains maths, natural science, physics, chemistry, history, geography, Arabic , English, French, and religion (Islamic or Christian).

8.Tell me about the manners of “delivery-development” in lessons?!

(Have the pupils to commit to their memories, more speaking or writing?)

The type of education is relating more to reciting more than interaction between teachers and students.

9.How is the relationship between the teacher and the pupil about?

It depends in the teacher himself but in general it is moderate.

10.How is the relationship between the teachers?

It is good in general.

11. How is the relationship between the school, the pupil and the parents?

It is an official relationship, usually schools don't call parents unless pupils do something bad.

12. How do teachers reward and punish pupils? (violence?)

Not much of reward, but violence is not permitted in schools so teachers do some types of punishments like make students stand in front of a wall or expel students for three days.

13. Please tell me about the relation from teenagers to the rest of the world -> (press, media, maybe relation to refugees)?

Teenagers now use internet and watch series, but not much of reading books.

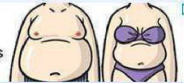
14. Does the state offer leisure facilities for teenagers? [projects, class trips]

1- introduce myself
My name is Anas Haj Mohamad, 25 years old, male ofcourse and working as electrical engineer. (you can mention my name in your study and it is not required to be anonymous)

My school was public, free of charge school and it contains both guys and girls (in general, most schools contains only guys or only girls so my school was unique).

I live in Damascus (the capital) suburbs and it considered as urban, my school was about 5 minutes far by walking.

I have a relatively big family (I have four sisters and am the youngest) my sisters are older than me by 9,8,6,4 years respectively . my father has one brother and one sister (so I have one uncle and one aunt from my father side).

My mother has two sisters and two brothers .
So in general I have three aunts and three uncles.
When I was a child all grandfathers and grandmothers were died and I didn't see anyone of them.
The family is strongly joint and everyone help the others by everything he/she can.

My character attributes are relatively shy (I was very shy when I was in the school), ambitious (I have the ambition to speak 6 languages and now I speak only three, to travel to many countries on my list, to get a master degree and to get married by a good woman and build a good family), working hard, relatively smart, love family and sacrifice for the family.

When I was in school between the age of 14 to 17, I and my friends usually run away from school one day in a month (without telling our families) and we go to have some mountains climbing (it was our secret and it was dangerous but we were happy to do it).
One of my best moments when we were climbing a mountains and two of my friends were angry with each other and suddenly one of them was about to fall down from the mountain and the other friend who was angry with him caught his hand and rescue him. And they return best friends.
Also we were used to play football one day a week even I was not good in playing football.

3- toughest punishment I got.
When I was 7 years old, I couldn't see well (because I needed to wear glasses) and I couldn't write well from the board to my notebook. And the teacher slapped me on my face because it was wrong what I was writing, because I couldn't see well. Even that slap was not so strong but it broke my feelings and I felt so bad to that teacher because I did nothing wrong and my mistake was that I couldn't see well, and still couldn't forgive that teacher.

When I was 14 years old one of my friends said a bad word to the teacher, but the teacher couldn't know who said that bad words. So that teacher take ten students including me and start our punishments by slapping us on our faces for more than one hour in a hope that someone will confess but no one confessed and no one told that teacher who did this. And after the end of that day, we gathered ourselves outside the school waiting that teacher and when we saw him we started to hit him and we broke his arm for what he did to us (now I don't believe in violence and we were just kids, of course two of my friend had to leave the school because we broke the arm of that teacher).

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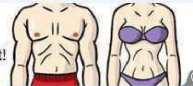

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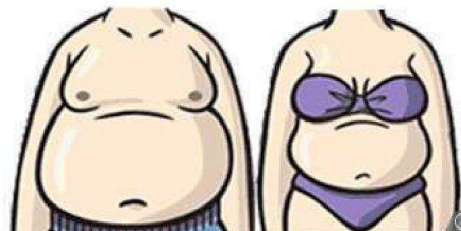


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
